### Safe Scheme Patrols:

#### **PC342 Firth Reports**

**On Thursday 22nd February between 5.45pm and 6.45pm** - I attended to Huddersfield Road, with a Marked Police van, and completed speed enforcement. This was using the home office approved pro laser speed detection device, capturing traffic in both directions. Weather was cold with the start of frost appearing.

Total cars - 837

30mph or less - 781 (93.3%)

31mph - 35mph - 47 (5.6%)

36mph to 40mph - 8 (enforceable) (0.9%)

41mph or over - 1 (0.2%)

During the same date. I returned to West Bretton to complete a later night initiative as part of the safe scheme between **11pm and 12am** - During this time, I was in an unmarked Police vehicle, patrol around West Bretton, looking for suspicious activity, burglaries and theft offences. Also included were the fly tipping locations throughout.

No incidents or suspicious activity was seen during this time. No one was seen acting unusual and/or fly tipping. Several vehicles were checked during this time, none needed Police action.

There was no calls for service during this time.

#### **PC342 Firth Reports**

**On Wednesday 21st February between 1130pm and 12.30am.** I attended to Bretton for safe scheme overtime. The plan was for Burglary/theft offences along with fly tipping.

Throughout the evening Vehicles were checked and streets attended to several times. I was in an unmarked Police vehicle. There were no one seen walking around the village at this time.

I attended the fly tipping areas and no litter were left and no one seen acting suspiciously.
